"This innovative model showcases a dining and living area that naturally extends to the outside onto the private side courtyard, perfect for entertaining or extending your living area to the outdoors."

On display for all to see is the two-storey, 2,154-sq.-ft. Aria model, featuring three bedrooms, 2.5 bathrooms, two-car rear-attached garage and styling true to the neighbourhood.

"Mahogany is well-known for the timeless architectural styles, rich palette of colours and premium materials used in the community," says Henderson. "The rear-attached homes are no different, with each home available in distinct elevations, ranging from Craftsman, Prairie, Arts and Crafts and Modern Country.

"The Aria showhome exterior is done in the Arts and Crafts style in stucco with cobble stone and Hardie siding details."

The Aria is striking from the front entrance, says Henderson.

"When you enter the foyer of the Aria you know this home is different than anything else you've seen," she says. "The traditional feeling of the home is felt immediately with the brushed oak flooring leading down the hallway and into the home and also through the cutout in the open, developed basement

The Aria's kitchen is at the rear of the home, looking directly out onto the private side courtyard and overlooking the dining room and entertainment area.

"The rich feel of the kitchen is a result of the colour of the cabinetry, briquette, a warm shade of brown that is only available to Sabal homeowners," says Henderson. "The Champagne-bronze finish of the hardware adds to the traditional feel of the home."

Large windows, overlooking the side courtyard and the front yard, let lots of natural light into the dining/entertainment room area.

"The dining room table sits nicely in front of the courtyard window," says Henderson. "The entertainment room is bathed in light from the front window, with the focal point being the fireplace with intricate tile surround.
